SERVICE AND SUSTAINABILITY AGREEMENT

This Agreement is signed on the date of, based on mutual understanding and cooperation between “Great Himalaya Trail” (hereinafter referred to as the ‘First Party’) and “Teahouse Lodge Provider” (hereinafter referred to as the ‘Second Party’).

1. Purpose

Work together to give good service to trekkers while protecting the environment and supporting local culture, people and economy.

2. Lodge Must Provide

- Clean rooms, toilets, showers, bedding, and towels.
- Safe kitchen: clean tools, fresh and healthy food with veg, vegan, and gluten-free options; include local dishes.
- Conserve: separate trash and recycle waste appropriately, compost food waste, save water, turn off lights, use gas or kerosene, and minimize the use of firewood.
- Emergency: first aid kit, fire extinguisher (recommended), clear fire exits.
- Staff: fair pay, no child labour, women’s involvement encouraged.
- Guests: respect privacy, no photos or personal info shared.

3. Always Keep at Lodge

- Great Himalaya Trail registration book / Guest comments book and pens.
- 24-hour contact phone (voice & SMS) where available.
- Stock of gas canisters, kerosene, local and packed dried food for sale for trekkers.

4. GHT Sign & Communication

- Keep GHT check-in post sign in good condition and in clear view of visitors.

5. Termination

Either side can end this agreement with 30 days’ notice. Great Himalaya Trail can end the contract immediately if:

- Safety, health, or environment rules are broken.
- Child labour or unsafe conditions are found.
- Lodge does not improve after warnings.
